

ORIGIN INFORMATION

The New Zealand Customs Regulations 1968 provide for tariff preference to be allowed to goods of Australian origin under one or other of the following categories:

GOODS WHOLLY PRODUCED OR WHOLLY MANUFACTURED	GOODS PARTLY MANUFACTURED
<p>These are goods which are the natural products of Australia which have not been subjected to any industrial processes except:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) those primary processes whereby natural products are ordinarily obtained from the farm, mine, forest, fisheries, etc., and; (b) the processes of cleaning, separating, sorting and drying and of the killing of animals <p>and includes goods wholly manufactured in Australia from materials of one or more of the following classes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Unmanufactured raw products; (ii) Materials wholly manufactured in Australia or in New Zealand or in Australia and New Zealand; (iii) Imported materials as determined by the Minister of Customs. <p>NOTE</p> <p>In respect of goods wholly manufactured the only non Australian/New Zealand materials permitted in goods claimed to qualify for preference under this category are those of (i) and (iii) above.</p>	<p>These are goods which do not qualify for preference under the foregoing category. Such goods will nevertheless qualify for preference provided:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) That the process last performed in the manufacture of the goods was performed in Australia; and (ii) That in respect of the goods, the expenditure — <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (A) In material that is of Australian origin or of New Zealand origin or of Australian and New Zealand origin; or (B) In labour and factory overheads incurred in Australia or in New Zealand or in Australia and New Zealand; or (C) In inner containers that are of Australian origin or of New Zealand origin or of New Zealand and Australian origin; or (D) Partly in such material and partly in such other items of factory cost (including inner containers) as aforesaid, is not less than half of the factory or works cost of the goods in their finished state: <p>Provided that —</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) With respect to any such goods imported into Niue, the reference in paragraph (ii) to not less than half of the factory or works cost shall be read as a reference to not less than one-quarter of the factory or works cost; and (ii) With respect to specific goods, the Minister may determine that the expenditure referred to in paragraph (ii) shall be greater than or less than half of the factory or works cost of the goods in their finished state.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Goods fail to qualify for preference should they enter the commerce of another country. (ii) This certificate is NOT to be used for goods which fail to meet the above preference criteria.
